

Prince of Wales and Duchess of Cornwall Scholarship and Queen's Diamond Jubilee



Prince of Wales and Duchess of Cornwall Scholarships

- Up to 20 scholarships of \$500
- Awarded annually to qualified nominees currently registered in Grade 11 at a Saskatchewan high school
- Recipients will receive their scholarship after registering for Grade 12 in fall 2020

Queen's Diamond Jubilee Scholarships

- Up to six scholarships of \$1000
- Awarded annually to qualified nominees currently registered in Grade 12 at a Saskatchewan high school
- Intended to assist with the first year of post-secondary education
- Grade 12 students must indicate the post-secondary institution that they will be attending effective September of the same school year as they graduated Grade 12.
- Recipients will receive the scholarship after registering for and beginning their post-secondary classes in fall 2020.

Scholarship Nomination Criteria

A selection committee will review all nominations received and will select qualified winners for both scholarships based on the following criteria:

1. School and/or community-based leadership
2. Responsibilities outside of school
3. Financial support needed
4. Academic performance

All nominees will be notified of the status of their application following the review process in the spring of each year. Recipients will receive a congratulatory letter before the end of the school year in which they were nominated.

Scholarship Application Requirements

Each scholarship application must be complete and include the following (see the on-line nomination form):

1. A completed nomination form from a SK High School
2. A letter of nomination from the school leadership team
3. A student profile
